Collections for business in July total \$4,973,810, an increase of 3.6% compared to the prior year.

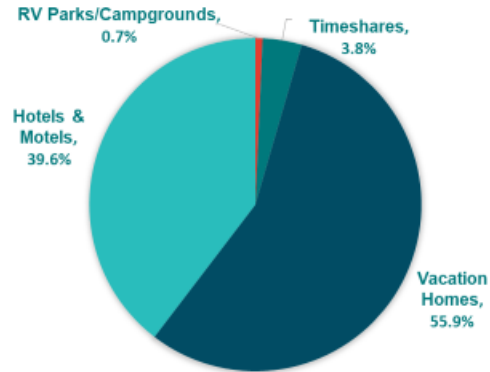

# OSCEOLA COUNTY TDT BREAKDOWN BY SEGMENT

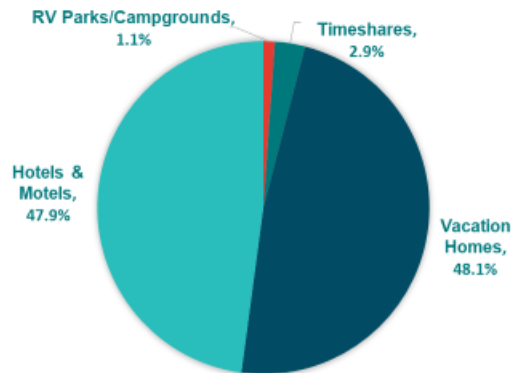
## BY THE NUMBERS: MONTHLY TDT COLLECTIONS

July TDT Collections (\$4.97M vs. \$4.80) increased 3.6% y/y



## BY THE NUMBERS: FY TDT COLLECTIONS

TDT collections (\$43.9M vs. \$41.9M) increased 4.7% YTD over last year
