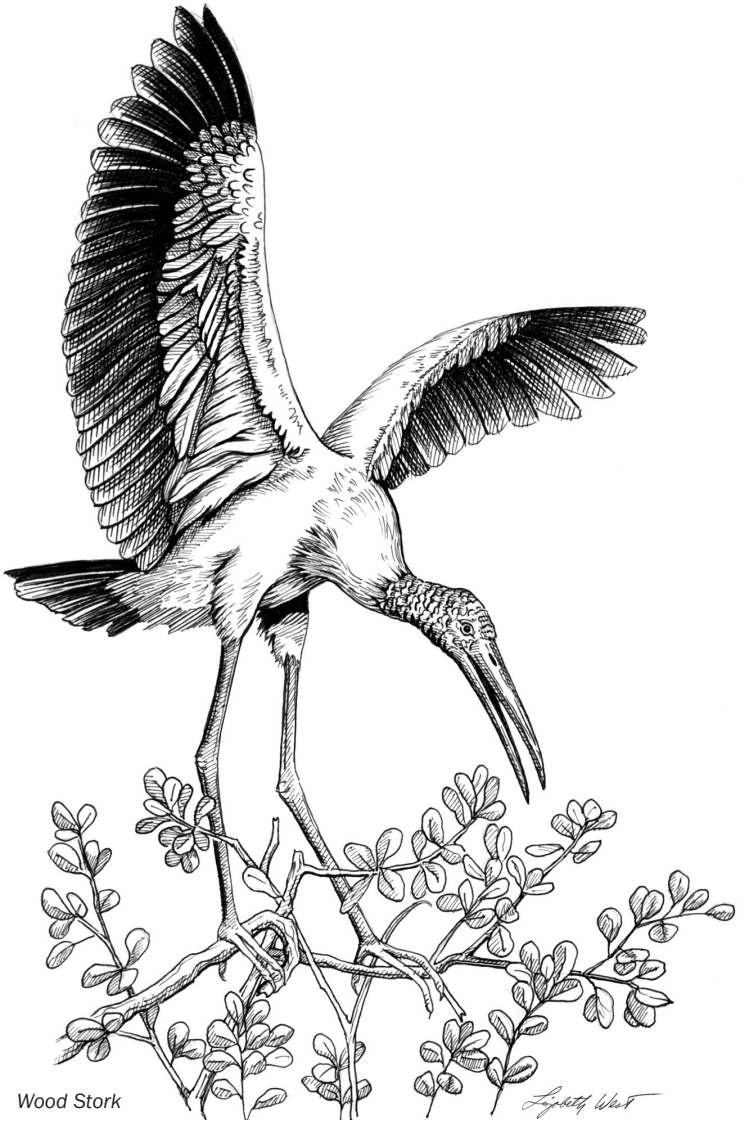

Checklist of Florida's Birds

Florida's wild places are home to an incredible diversity of birds. More than 500 native bird species or naturally occurring strays have been recorded in the state and over 300 native species occur commonly (four have gone extinct). A further 17 nonnative species (exotics) have established large stable populations in Florida, as shown by research. More than 70 natural community types support this diversity, from the pine flatwoods of Apalachicola National Forest to the scrub communities of the Lake Wales Ridge, and the vast sawgrass marshes and mangrove swamps of Everglades National Park. Our natural areas harbor many bird species seen nowhere else in the United States, such as the Florida Scrub-Jay, Mangrove Cuckoo and Snail Kite. In addition, Florida's birdlife changes with the cycle of the seasons. A constant turnover of breeding, wintering and migratory species provides new birding experiences throughout the year.

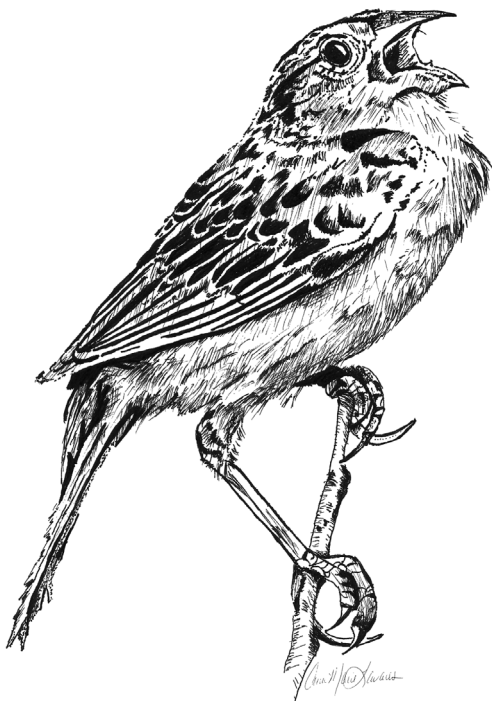
To help you keep track of the spectacular range of birdlife the state has to offer, the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) has published this checklist based on verified records of native birds and established nonnative species (exotics). Some birds are noted as rare in Florida; extra care should be taken in identifying these rarer species and observations should be documented with photographs, video or sound recordings if possible. The checklist also notes species listed as threatened or endangered. In cases where multiple subspecies are found in the state and only a subset are listed as threatened or endangered, this information is included in a footnote.

This booklet is also the official checklist of the Wings Over Florida birding certificate program. Wings Over Florida awards full-color certificates at seven different achievement levels to birders who report their Florida life lists to the FWC. See more info on page 25.

Wings Over Florida

The Wings Over Florida program awards full-color certificates at six achievement levels to birdwatchers who report their life lists to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. In addition, a Big Year certificate is awarded to those who report their annual observation list. This program is free to residents and nonresidents.

Available certificates include:

Ruby-throated Hummingbird (25 species)

Roseate Spoonbill (50 species)

Florida Scrub-Jay (100 species)

Crested Caracara (200 species)

Red-cockaded Woodpecker (300 species)

Mangrove Cuckoo (400 species)

Big Year Certificate (at least 50 species in the calendar year)

Official Rules

1. No Exotic species can be counted; no captive, escaped birds can be counted.
2. All birds listed must be alive, wild, and unrestrained when observed.
3. All birds listed must be identified by sight or sound by the person submitting the application.
4. Only one individual may be listed on each certificate awarded.

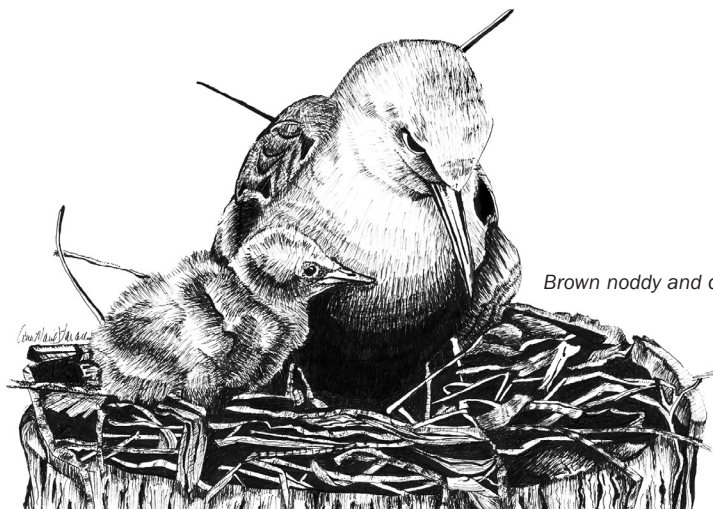
